STATEMENT OF FAITH: CHRISTIAN AND MISSIONARY ALLIANCE OF CANADA

- 1. There is one God who is infinitely perfect, existing eternally in three persons: Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- Is. 44:6; 45:5-6; Matt. 5:48; Deut. 3:24; Matt. 3:16-17; 28:19
 Jesus Christ is true God and true man. He was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He died upon the cross, the Just for the unjust, as a substitutionary sacrifice, and all who believe in Him are justified on the ground of His shed blood. He arose from the dead according to the Scriptures. He is now at the right hand of the Majesty on High as our great High Priest. He will come again to establish His kingdom of righteousness and peace. Phil. 2:6-11; Heb. 2:14-18; Col. 2:9; Matt. 1:18; Luke 1:35; 1 Cor. 15:3-5; 1 John 2:2; Acts 13:39; Heb. 4:14-15; 9:24-28; Matt. 25:31-34; Acts 1:11
- The Holy Spirit is a divine Person, sent to indwell, guide, teach and empower the believer, and to convince the world of sin, of righteousness and of judgment.

- The Old and New Testaments, inerrant as originally given, were verbally inspired by God and are a complete revelation of His will for the salvation of people. They constitute the divine and only rule of Christian faith and practice.

- 5. Humankind, originally created in the image and likeness of God, fell through disobedience, incurring thereby both physical and spiritual death. The local church, the visible expression of the universal Church, is a body of believers in Christ who are joined together to worship God, to observe the ordinances of Baptism and the Lord's Supper, to pray, to be edified through the Word of God, to fellowship, and to testify in word and deed to the good news of salvation both locally and globally. The local church enters into relationships with other like-minded churches for accountability, encouragement and mission.
